This Privacy Policy applies to the our Web site and governs data collection and usage. By using our website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

Collection of your Personal Information

We collect personally identifiable information, such as your e-mail address, name, and home or work address.

There is also information about your computer hardware and software that is automatically collected by our website. We keep track of the Web sites and pages our customers visit within www.DivorceLiaison.com, in order to determine which of our services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within our web site to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

We will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on us or the site; (b) protect and defend our rights or property; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of our web site, or the public.

Use of Cookies; Tracking Devices

We use "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize our web site pages, or register with our web site or services, a cookie helps us to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. We may also utilize pixel tags and web beacons provided by our affiliates and/or marketing partners for the same purposes.

Security of your Personal Information

We secure your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. We secure the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other Web sites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
